

SANTILLANA DEL MAR, COMILLAS Y SAN VICENTE DE LA BARQUERA

10:00 AM - Arrival at SANTILLANA DEL MAR

In the western coast of Cantabria, you can find two of the biggest cultural treasures in the region: Santillana del Mar. Santillana del Mar is 30 km far from Santander and it is an "alive museum" of a medieval village developed around the "Santa Juliana" collegiate church, although most of the houses were built between the XIV century and the XVIII one. The whole Santillana can only be visited on foot.

12.00 PM - COMILLAS

The town of Comillas is one of Cantabria's most symbolic places and one of its most interesting from an architectural point of view. It has some of the most important Art Nouveau buildings in Cantabria, which include Sobrellano Palace Chapel and the Pantheon, the Pontifical University and, of course, the brilliant El Capricho by Antonio Gaudi.

14.00 PM - RUILOBA

Ruiloba is a beautiful county on the western coast of Cantabria with a XIX century church and some of the most spectacular cliffs you have ever seen. We will have lunch at the "Restaurante el Remedio" with views over the ocean, Comillas and the "Picos de Europa" mountains.

17.00 PM - SAN VICENTE DE LA BARQUERA

In the afternoon we will visit San Vicente, a fishing village with one of the most significant fishing ports on the region.

19.00 PM RETURN TO SANTANDER
