

## **CABÁRCENO Y LIÉRGANES**

## 10:00 AM - ARRIVE AT CABÁRCENO

This nature reserve is in a man-made setting created on a karstic landscape on 750 hectares of an old open-cut mine. It features many animals threatened with extinction, like African elephants, Grévy's zebras and white rhinoceros.

Conceived with the purpose of educating, promoting cultural and scientific knowledge, and for recreation, it has become one of Cantabria's most popular tourist attractions. It houses more than one hundred animal species from all five continents, which can be seen practically in the wild, as they are housed in large areas in completely natural settings.

## 18.30 PM - LIÉRGANES

This Cantabrian town was declared to be of National Historic-Artistic Interest in 1978 and gathers together a valuable collection of classicist architecture from the 17th and 18th centuries.

Liérganes sits at the foot of two small hills, Marimón and Cotillamón, popularly known as "the breasts of Liérganes". The old part of town, named El Mercadil, as well as popular large houses, contains the Palace of Rañada or Cuesta-Mercadillo, the church of San Sebastián, the parish church of San Pedro Ad Víncula, the houses of Setién and Cañones, the chapels of Humilladero and El Carmen and the new bridge.
